

**‘Show what Sussex nature means to you’
Sussex Nature Recovery prize draw for kids and young adults aged 5-17 years old**

Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

Entrants under 18 must get consent from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) before entering. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of entrants under 18 agree to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the entrant.

1. The prize draw is being run by Wayforward on behalf of West Sussex County Council, as part of activities to engage residents of Sussex and Brighton & Hove in the development of Local Nature Recovery Strategies for Sussex.
2. You are providing your information to Wayforward on behalf of West Sussex County Council. Any information provided will be used in conjunction with the following [Data Protection Policy](#).
3. The prize draw is open to all entrants in East Sussex, West Sussex and Brighton & Hove, aged 5-17 years.
4. Entries open at 8am 3rd June and close at 23:59pm on 30th September 2024. All entries must be received by the closing time and date. Entries received after the closing time and date will not be included in the prize draw.
5. To enter, entrants must submit either:
 - a photo they have taken,
 - a photo of a drawing they have made,
 - a poem they have written,

in response to one of four ‘show us what nature means to you’ statements. Photos or poems must be uploaded to the ‘What Sussex nature Means to you’ prize draw page on the www.SussexNatureRecovery.org.uk website, and all relevant sections of the submission form completed. No payment, purchase or investment is necessary.

6. Any submissions must be the entrants original work and must not contain material that violates or infringes another’s rights, including but not limited to privacy, publicity or intellectual property rights, or that constitutes copyright infringement.
7. Submissions must not contain material that is inappropriate, indecent, obscene, hateful, tortious, defamatory, slanderous or libellous, or that promotes bigotry, racism, hatred or harm against any group or individual or promotes discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age; and must not contain material that violates any laws or regulations.
8. By submitting an entry, entrants confirm that no animals were harmed or manipulated in the making of the photo, drawing or poem.
9. Entrants retain full copyright over their submissions, but by submitting their entry consent to their submission being shared publicly on the SussexNatureRecovery.org.uk website and in related materials such as the Sussex

Nature Recovery e-newsletter. The first name, age, and District/Borough of the entrant will also be shared along with their submission.

10. If entrants change their mind, they can request that their submission, first name, age or county is removed from public-facing materials by contacting team@wayforwardbrighton.com. Please allow 7 days for any changes to be implemented.
11. Each entrant can provide a maximum of 5 submissions. However, only one prize will only be awarded per household.
12. The prize is a £25 Post Office One4all Gift Card. There are a total of ten £25 One4All Gift Cards to be won.
13. Wayforward will not be responsible for any entries that are not received by it for any reason, by the closing date, whether lost, delayed, corrupted or otherwise, and whether or not due to any technical difficulties or malfunctions.
14. Unclear entries will not be eligible for the prize draw and acceptance of an entry is subject to Wayforward's reasonable discretion.
15. Within five working days after the closing date, the winners of this prize draw will be drawn at random by Wayforward from all valid entries received. The winners will be randomly selected using a number generator and this will be completely independent and unbiased. Wayforward's decision is final on all matters and no correspondence will be entered into.
16. The first 10 valid entries to be drawn will win the prizes. If a winning entrant is drawn more than once, the second entry will not be valid for a prize, and a new randomly selected entry will be drawn.
17. The winners will be contacted by email. Wayforward will endeavour to notify the winners within 5 working days of the prize draw taking place. If, after reasonable attempts, a winner cannot be contacted, or a winner refuses the prize for any reason, Wayforward reserves the right to offer the prize to the next randomly selected person that entered the prize draw, and so on until the winner is found.
